Decisions from 71st CEN/BT TCMG - 99th CEN/BT - 175th CLC/BT

Processes and operational matters

First working drafts

The BTs strongly recommend TC Working Groups (WG) to circulate at least one first Working Draft (WD) to their parent Technical Body for information or, upon discretion of the TB leadership in consultation with the WG Convenor, for comments.

The IR2 (Clause 11.2.1.5) will be modified accordingly, removing the mandatory aspect of the submission.

Cooperation with EC/EFTA

Homegrown harmonized Standards - Innovative process

To tackle the persistent difficulties of having compliant assessments by the HAS consultants on homegrown harmonized Standards (hENs) candidate for citation in the OJEU, the BTs have endorsed an **innovative process** that has been specifically devised for those cases.

The objective of this new process is to improve the timely delivery of compliant harmonized Standards by:

- introducing the concept of 'Mature draft' and 'Pre-FV assessment'
- introducing the new CCMC Quality Check (QC)

A **webinar** dedicated to the innovative process was held on 25 September. The recordings and material are available on the <u>CEN expert area</u> and <u>CENELEC expert area</u>.

In line with the BT decisions, the innovative process systematically applies **to all NWIs for homegrown** hENs launched for approval as of **1 October 2023**.

However, to already have an impact on ongoing projects, the TCs are **strongly encouraged** to request a CCMC Quality Check on WIs not yet submitted to Enquiry (30.99) or Formal Vote (45.99). To do so, they are invited to send their request by email to the Harmonised Standards Compliance team (https://documents.org/leg/hs/4/9/), together with all necessary elements and supporting documents (filled in common checklist, EU Annexes, etc.).

Furthermore, it is worth mentioning that a similar process for draft harmonized Standards in parallel development with ISO & IEC is under discussion within the CEN-CENELEC-ISO-IEC-EC Brainstorming Group. This process should reduce the risk of having a document blocked at the end of the parallel development at CEN or CENELEC level while not slowing down the international process, and increase the chances of having an identical international and harmonized European standard.

Harmonized Standards compliance - Use of new checklist

Since 1 October 2023 the use of the new checklist, *identical* for the ESOs (and their Technical Bodies), the HAS consultants and the EC, has become mandatory to assess the compliance of ENs developed in view of their citation in the OJEU, ensuring that the same criteria are applied by all parties.

The **checklist** is available on the <u>CEN</u> and <u>CENELEC</u> BOSS.

A **webinar** was given on 23 June 2023, presenting the new checklist and explaining the main differences with the previous one.

Harmonized Standards - Alignment to Machinery Regulation

The <u>Machinery Regulation</u> (EU) 2023/1230 (MR) will apply from 2027-01-20 ('application date'). Until then, the current Machinery Directive 2006/42/EC (MD) is applicable.

CEN and CENELEC are expected to start developing harmonized standards (hENs) in support of the MR so that such standards are available before its application date. The work will be framed by a new Standardization Request in support of the MR, which is still under development.

Considering the intricate situation during the transition period and to smoothen the citation of hENs in the Machinery sector, the BTs concurred with the advice from the CEN-CENELEC Sector Forum on Machinery (in agreement with the EC) and decided to take an exceptional approach for those Standards i.e.

- Technical Bodies developing hENs for machinery should include two informative Annexes Z, one for the MD and the second for the MR, in deliverables intended to be published (DAV) between the adoption of the MR Standardization Request (expected in second half of 2024) and 2026-03-31 (the expected last possible date of publication of standards for the MD).
- A Technical Body can apply only the informative Annex Z for the MD for those cases where a hEN intends to specifically address minor issues under the MD, for example the non-citation in OJEU.
- The Technical Bodies Secretaries should ensure that for hENs under Machinery planned to be published (DAV) in the transition period, the NWI form includes the information whether a hEN is linked with the MD only, or with both the MD and the MR.

Accessibility of documents in Word and PDF

CEN/BTWG 13 'Strategic Advisory Group on Accessibility (SAGA)' has developed revised 'Guidelines to accessible Word and PDF documents'. The Guidelines contain instructions for those Technical Bodies wishing to ensure their documents (other than European Standards, which follow the CEN Simple Template) are accessible to the widest possible audience.

CENELEC matters

Developing European elements to harmonized Standards within SRs

When there is a need for developing harmonization elements in a European Standard included in the portfolio of a Reporting Secretariat (SR), the CENELEC Member in charge of the SR can ask the ad-hoc creation of a BT Task Force (CLC/BTTF), in principle under that Member's convenorship. Once the European elements have been published, the deliverable is transferred to the SR for maintenance.

CENELEC Members holding SRs are invited to raise horizontal general issues related to harmonized standards under SRs with the secretariat of CEN-CLC/BTWG 12 'Harmonized standards and the European regulatory framework'.

Calculation of implementation dates in CENELEC deliverables

The calculation of the national implementation dates of CENELEC deliverables will be calculated on the DAV (date of availability) instead of the DOR (date of ratification), and their duration will be aligned for homegrown and parallel process:

DOA = DAV + 6 months DOP = DAV + 12 months DOW = DAV + 36 months

NWIs approval - Voting tool

Pursuant to Decision D172/C118, through which BT agreed to delegate the approval of NWIs to TCs pending the availability of the needed IT tools, CLC/BT decided to start the new process as of 1 February 2024.

In the new Voting tool, weighted vote will apply for the approval of NWIs intended to become EN, TS and HD, while TRs will be approved via simple majority, in line with the voting criteria in Clause 6 of IR2.

CCMC will organize a dedicated webinar at the attention of the TCs in January 2024.
