



How to set the Work Programme?

The Work Programme under a Standardization Request (Reg. 1025/2012)



- ▲ *'harmonised standard' means a European standard adopted on the basis of a request made by the Commission for the application of Union harmonisation legislation (art. 2c)*
- ▲ *At least once a year, each ESO and NSB shall establish its work programme. That WP shall contain information which a ESO or NSB intends to prepare or amend, which is preparing or amending, and which it has adopted (...) (art. 3.1.)*
- ▲ ESO have a legal obligation to keep their Work Programmes under each Standardization Request updated and available!

Before the formal acceptance of the Standardization Request by CEN-CENELEC

- ▲ Comment the drafts circulated to CEN and CENELEC BT for information
- ▲ Participate in the SRAHG (Standardization Request Ad-hoc Group) meetings organized by CCMC

- ▲ Start building your Work Programme (i.e. list the standards that cover the essential requirements described in the Standardization Request). In general, the first WP is sent to European Commission one month after the formal reception of the Standardization Request
- ▲ Contact the relevant Project Manager to be involved. The PM is the bridge between the Technical Bodies and the European Commission

After the formal acceptance of the Standardization Request by CEN-CENELEC

- ▲ Be informed. All Standardization Requests are publicly available (<http://ec.europa.eu/growth/tools-databases/mandates/>)
- ▲ Use Projex-Online (or CEN-CENELEC website) to check the Work Programme under each SReq
- ▲ Keep the data regarding your Work Items updated in the database. Inform CCMC of possible errors or inconsistencies
- ▲ Contact the CCMC Project Manager if changes to Work Programme accepted by the European Commission are required (e.g. add a new standard)
